Section 1—Pain Intensity

Section 1 – Pain Intensity

- 0. The pain comes and goes and is very mild.
- 1. The pain is mild and does not vary much.
- 2. The pain comes and goes and is moderate.

- 5. The pain is severe and does not vary much.

Section 2 – Personal Care (Washing, Dressing, etc.)

Section 7 – Sleeping

Section 8 – Social Life

Section 9 – Traveling
